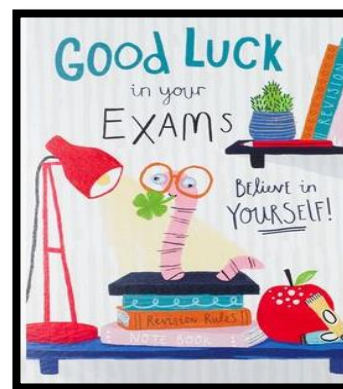

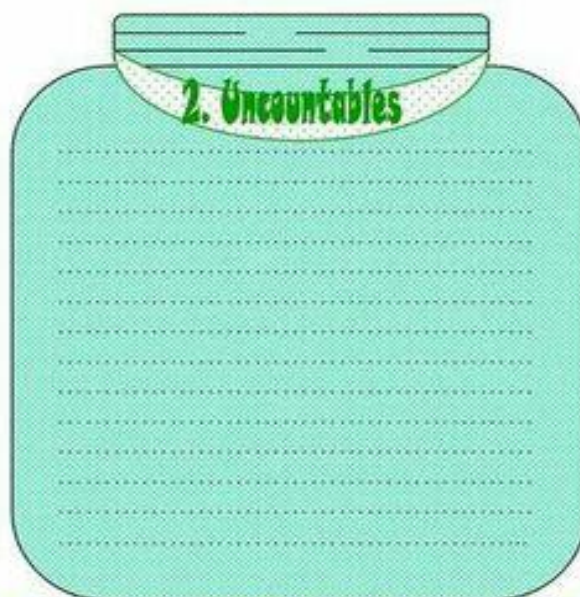
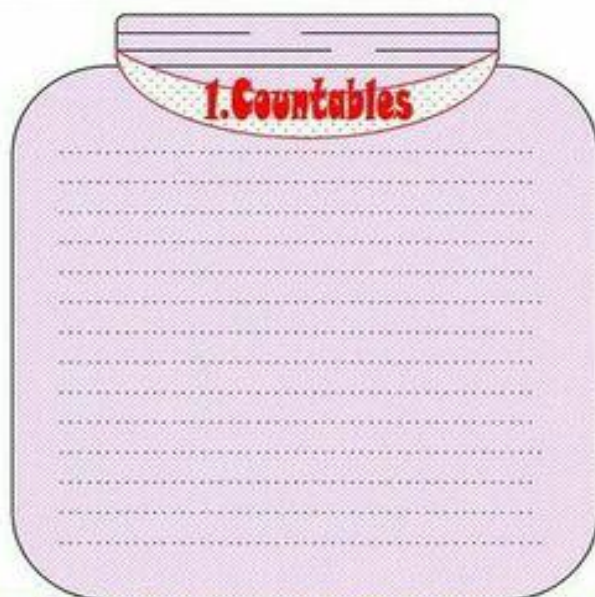

- For verbs that end in e, remove the e and add **ING** ...DANCE-- DANC**ING**
- For verbs that end in ie, change the ie to y and add **ING**. ... TIE-- TY**ING**
- For a verb whose last syllable is written with a consonant-vowel-consonant and is stressed, double the last letter before adding **ING**. STOP—STOP**PING**

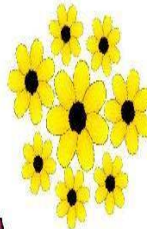
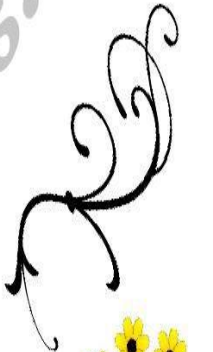
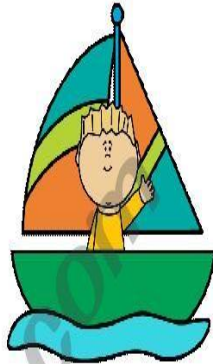
